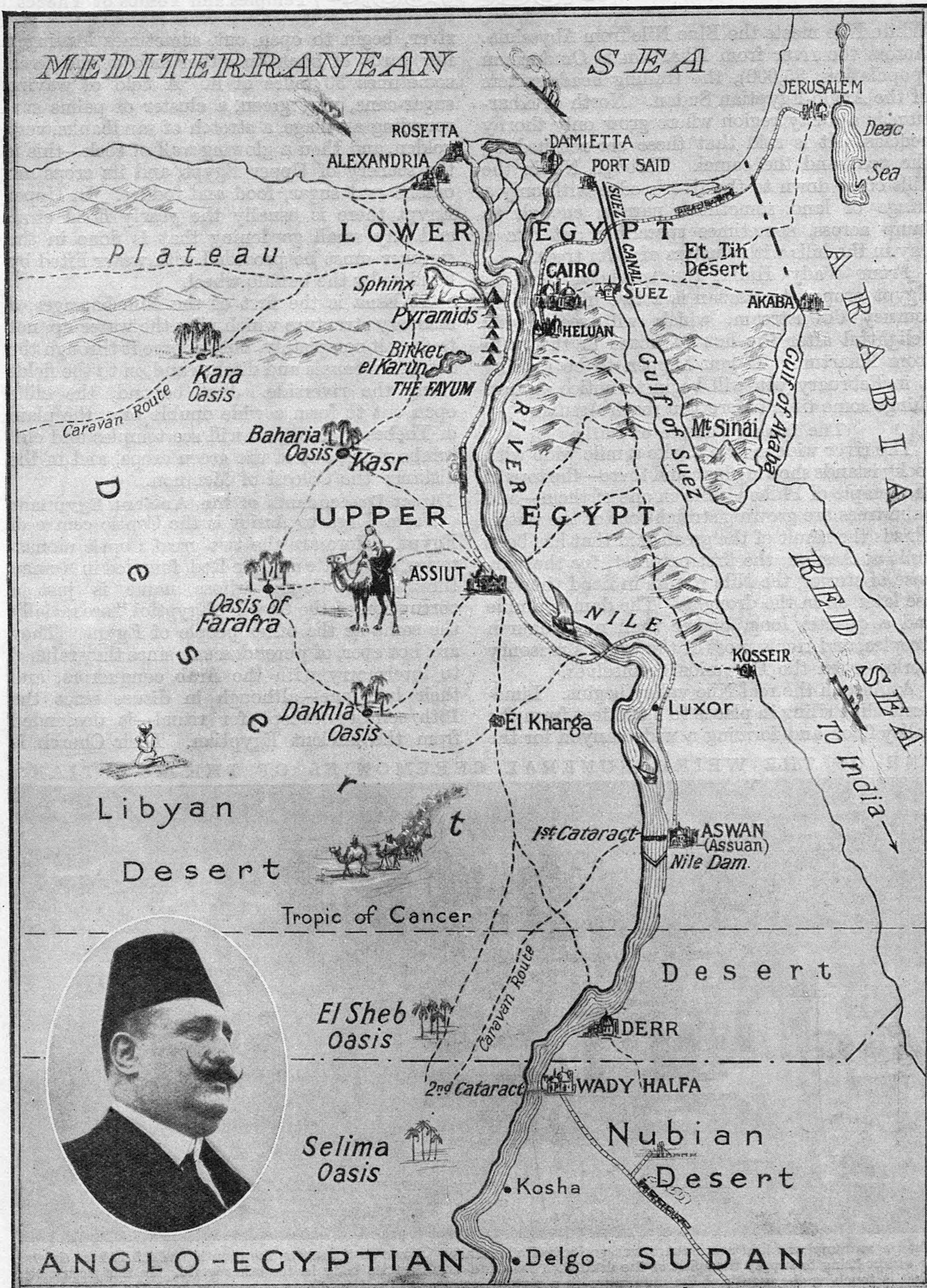


THE COUNTRY THAT THE PHARAOHS RULED
