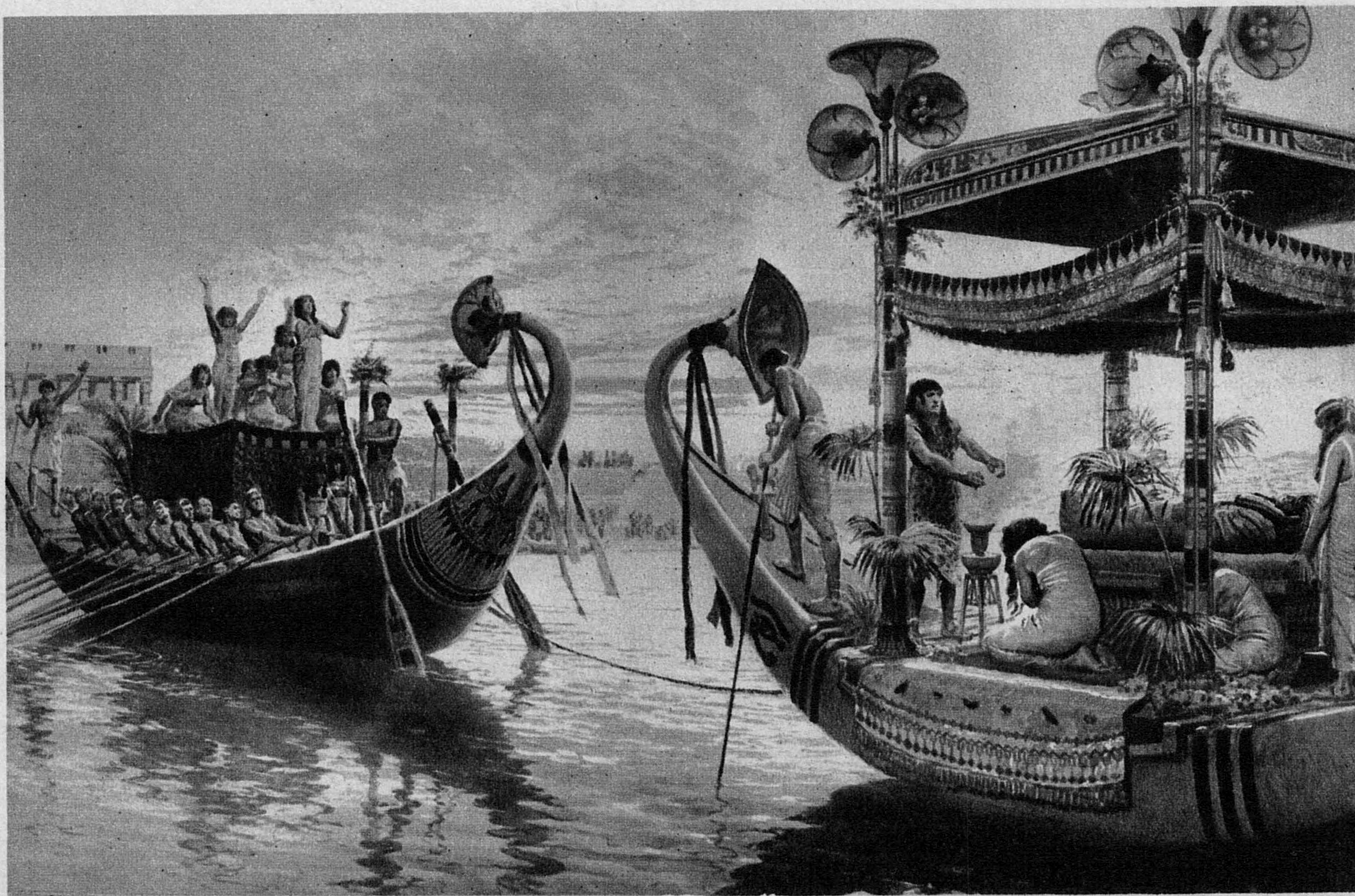
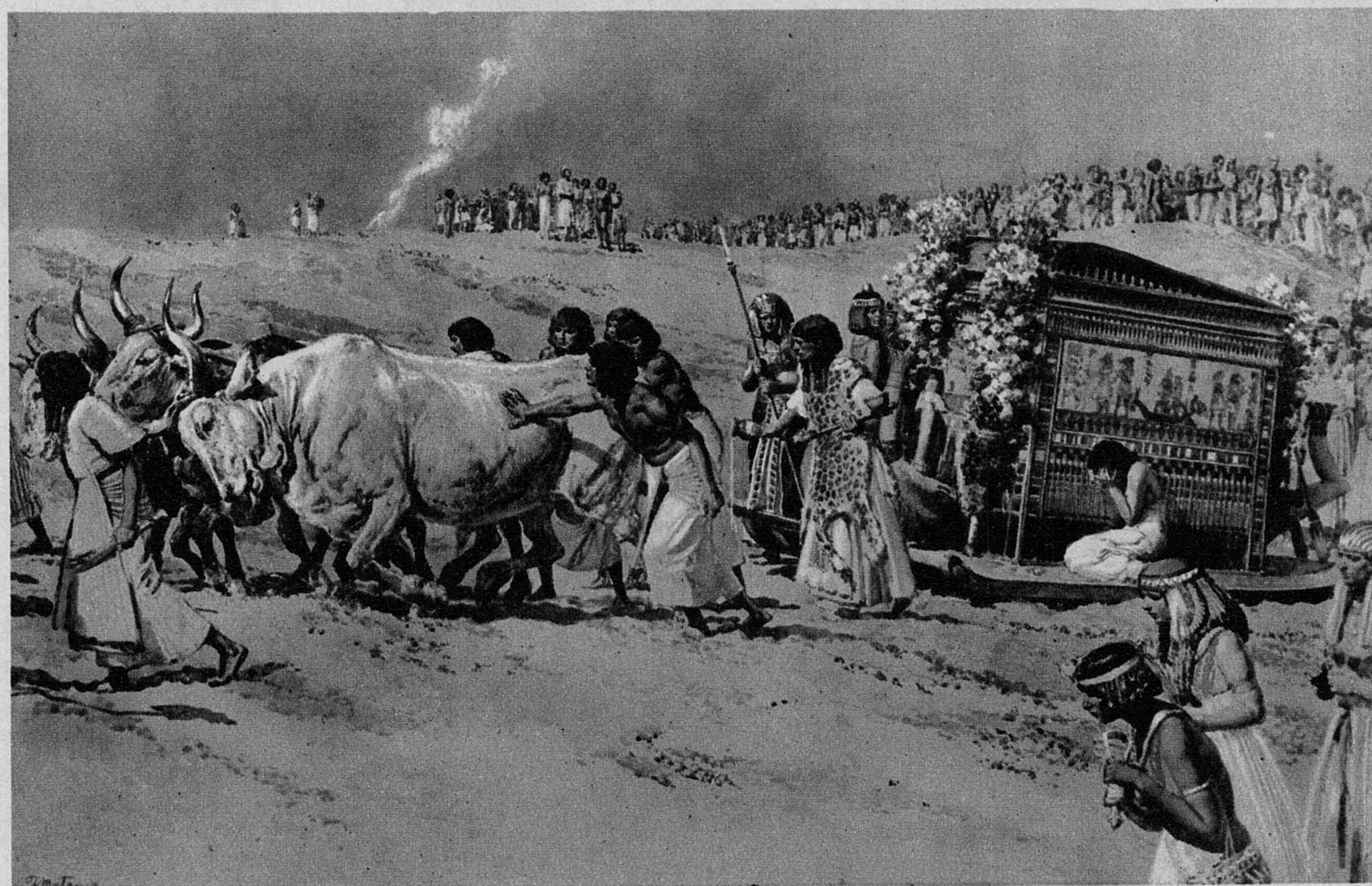


THE FUNERAL PROCESSION OF AN ANCIENT PHARAOH



Funerals of great persons in ancient Egypt were carried out with much ceremony. Here we see the mummy being ferried across the Nile, towed by a boat containing relations and professional mourners.



After the body has reached the other side of the Nile, the funeral procession crosses the plain to the burial place. The shrine is drawn by four oxen, which are sacrificed at the entrance to the tomb.
