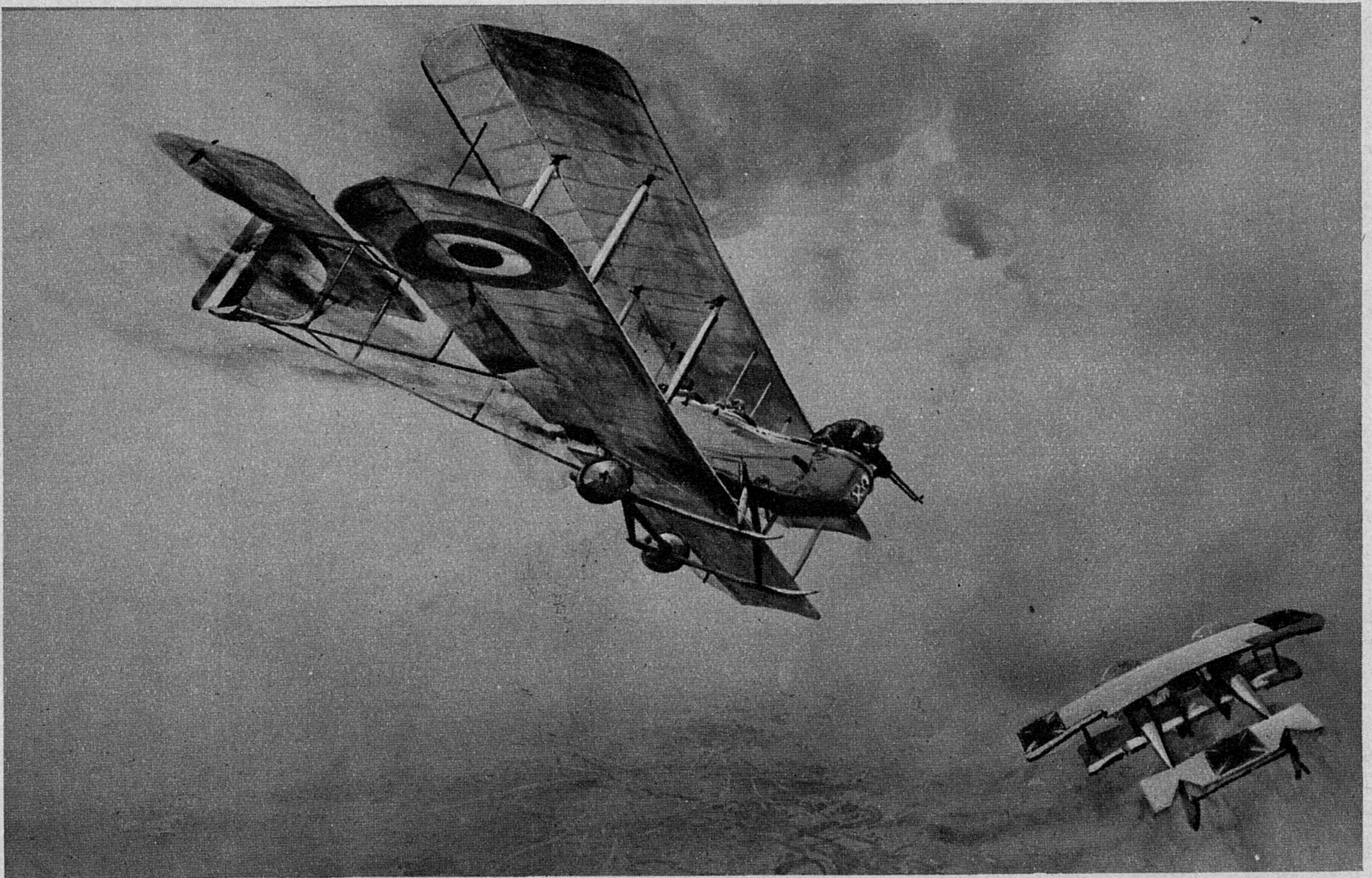
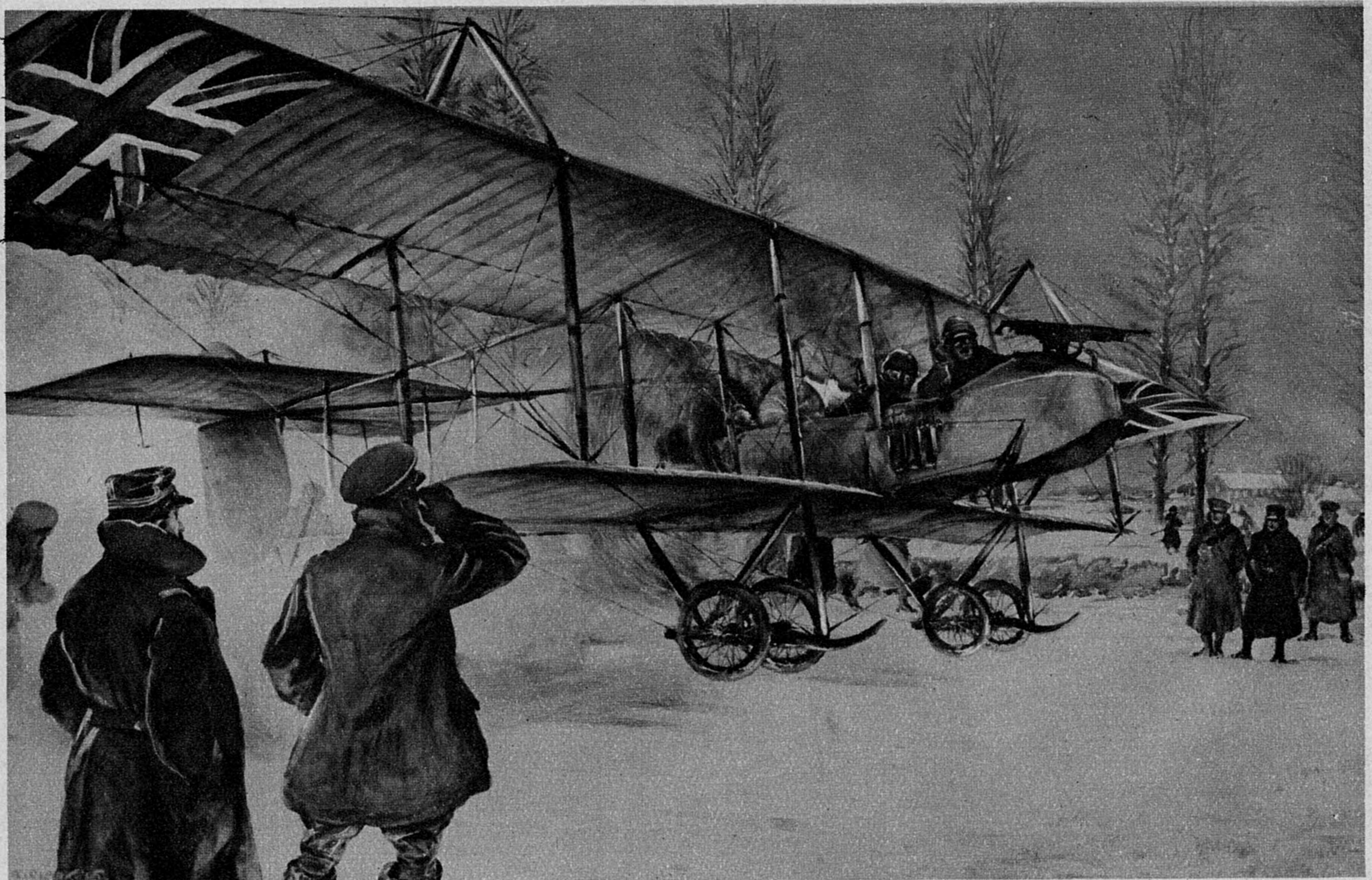


FIGHTING A GERMAN GIANT IN MID-AIR
