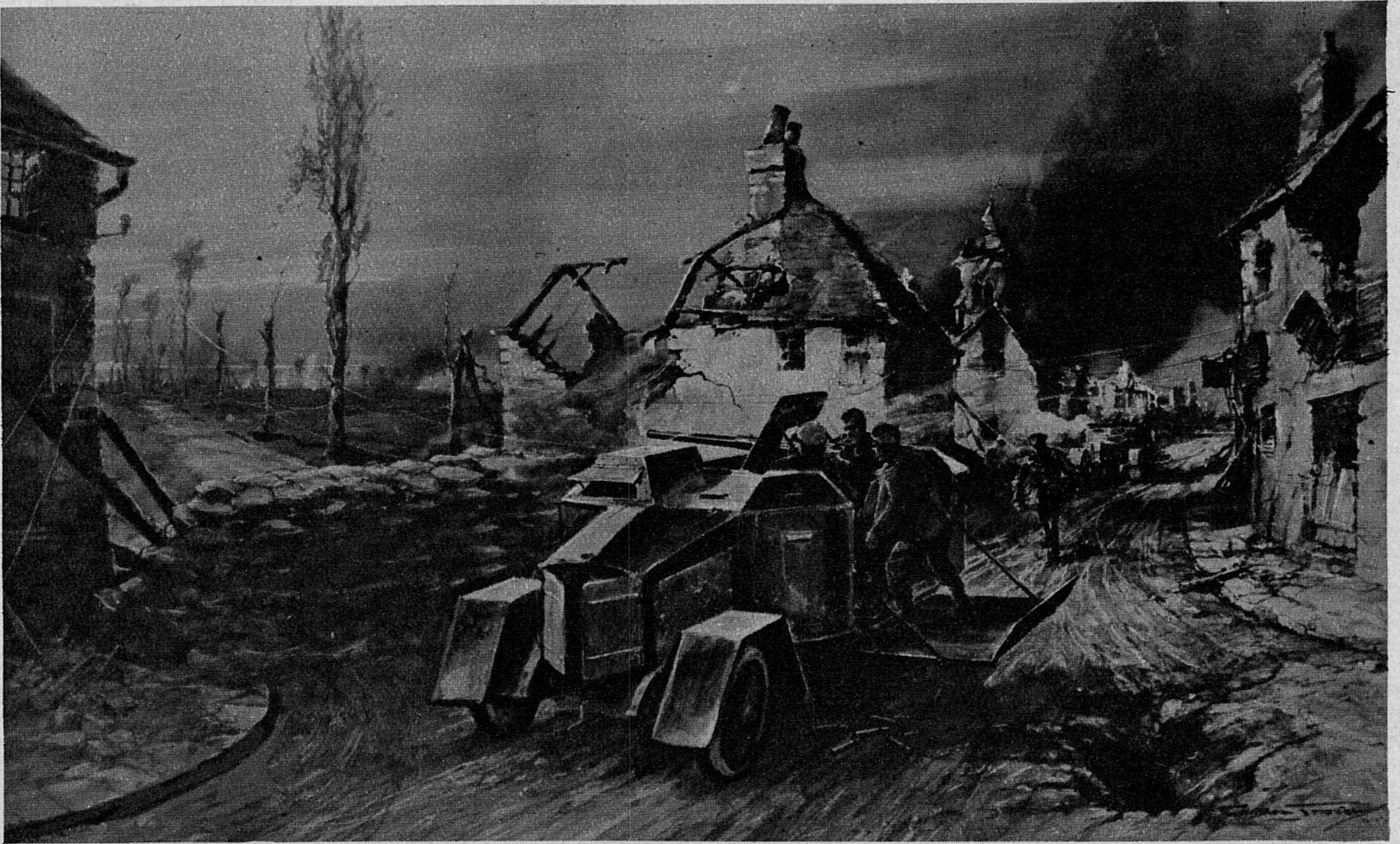
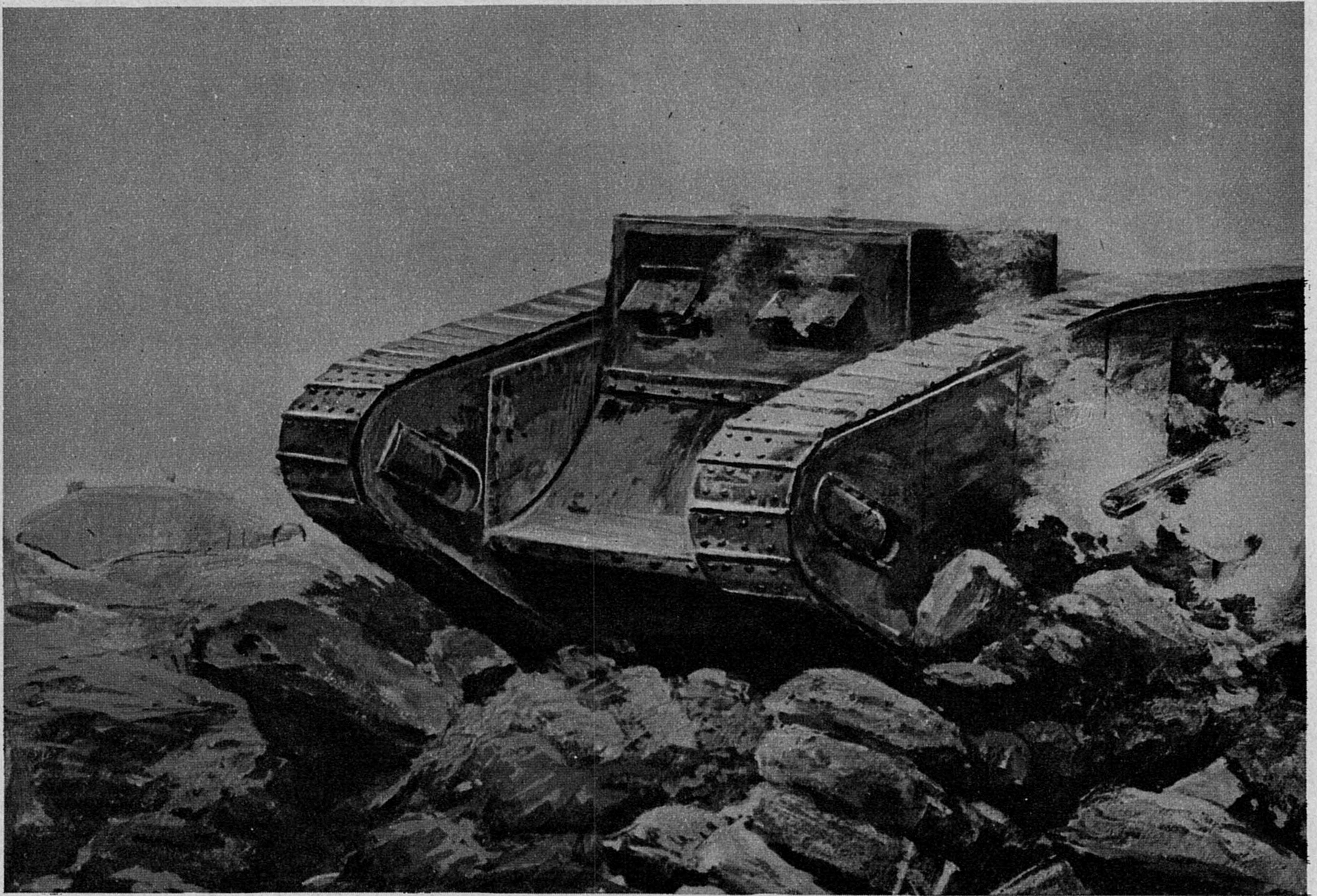


TANK IN ACTION ON THE WESTERN FRONT
